Once again, the unpredictable migratory movements of the North Atlantic Right Whales have created further legislated changes to vessels travelling the Gulf of St Lawrence shipping lanes. Further changes in operations to meet the new requirements have increased operational Ferry costs. These changes were implemented by our Ferry provider as of July 20, 2019. We will implement this update to the current fee on shipments picked up today and moving on subsequent sailings. We do apologize for the lack of advance notice on this uniquely regional environmental issue we are faced with.
